INCOMPLETE POLICY

- 1. If a student has a valid, extenuating circumstance and they believe that they will not be able to complete the coursework in time, a student may request an Incomplete grade for the course.
- 2. To qualify, students must have completed at least 50% of coursework by the time of the request.
- 3. Requests must be submitted no later than the last day of class.
- 4. Students must have been maintaining a satisfactory (passing) status in the class.
- 5. Missed assignments will need to be completed and submitted within two weeks of the last day of class. Assignments not submitted by the end of the two weeks will receive a failing grade for the assignments, and the "I" grade for the course will change to "F."
- 6. Requests for an Incomplete need to be approved by the Instructor, Dean, and Administration.

COURSE UNIT POLICY

St. Bede's courses are entirely online, with instructional content (lecture activity--written, video, or audio) uploaded within each course. One week of lecture material is considered equivalent to 1 hour of instruction. Assignments, posts and tasks are equal to 2 hours of student homework per week. While course participation is essentially *asynchronous* (*i.e.*, students participate and complete tasks on their own - instruction is not delivered in real time and in person), *synchronous* presentations (*i.e.*, through scheduled participation and inperson, *e.g.*, Zoom sessions), may be set up at the discretion of the instructor.

One course is equivalent to one unit.
